#### School Year Resumes with PRSD Back-to-school Re-Entry Plan

The staff at Paul Rowe welcome students, parents & the community to the 2021-2022 school year.

The new school year is underway, and students and staff are settling into our new routines. We are happy to announce that the 2021-2022 Alberta Education School Year Plan and the corresponding Peace River School Division Back-to-school Re-Entry Plan has allowed us to resume some programs and activities previously suspended due to COVID-19 restrictions.

As per the Alberta Government's recent announcement regarding the re-introduction of health regulations, the PRSD plan was updated, with changes taking effect on September 8. The main change for our school is that we are once again required to wear masks in all shared areas of the school. Note: masks are still not required while students are seated in the classroom, but students who choose to wear a mask and/or social distance will be supported.

# Breakfast Club




# Breakfast Club students will meet with Mrs. Goodzeck on Tuesdays and/or Fridays during SOLE to help prepare these breakfast foods.
